

## PARTNERSHIPS CREATED TO SUPPORT ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITIES



- Youth & Private Sector Advisory Group established.
- Workshop facilitated to support the development of the Operational Plan 2024.
- MLSP and ESA supported in conducting outreach among unemployed youth.
- 2,100+ youth participated in the research on 'Youth Career and Skills Aspirations'.
- 100+ youth participated in youth discussions, organized in collaboration with MLSP.
- Support in the establishment of a PLC programming training center provided and four employees from Amphenol and SS 'Gosho Vikentiev' in Kocani trained to become trainers in the center.
- 55 youth participated in Green Solutions Hackathon.
- 50 youth took part in Climathon Skopje 2023, organized with CEED Hub Skopje.
- Challenge for Establishing a Green Jobs Training Hub announced with the Fund for Innovation and Technological Development.
- 25 youth took part in a social entrepreneurship hackathon.
- 50 students participated in a social entrepreneurship training.
- Seven startups participated in CEED Hub's Investment Readiness Program.

## YOUTH'S COMPETENCIES FOR JOBS, PROGRESSIVE CAREERS, AND CIVIC LIFE STRENGTHENED



- 72 young people gained entrepreneurial skills through the Youth Talks format.
- 21 youth were trained under CEED Hub's Acceleration Program 2023/2024.
- Draft Strategy for Enhancement of UKIM's Career Center developed.
- 432 young people received career guidance and counseling.
- · 1,400+ youth enrolled in internships and employment, as well as in advanced IT and HR training sessions under the Operational Plan 2023.
- 34 youth gained cyber hygiene, security, and privacy skills during the Cyber Security Summer School.
- 74 youth discussed cyber security, cyber hygiene, and privacy topics during two Cyber Shake sessions.
- 25 young people enhanced their practical skills in 3D printing, scanning, and modeling.
- 28 youth were trained in 3D modeling and Computer Numerical Control technology application.





## VALUES AND EXPERIENCE THAT UNDERPIN SELF-RELIANCE PROMOTED



- 35 youth organizations mapped to understand the youth landscape in the country, providing guidance, support, and mentoring to 10 of them.
- Youth Summit organized to build the capacities and enable networking for 100 participants from the mapped youth organizations.
- 20 young individuals participated in a Youth-led Research and Advocacy Program.
- More than six youth-led events supported, with 600+ youth involved.
- **60+ youth** mentored in skill development, leadership, and community cohesion.
- 150 young people participated in ethics compliance lectures.
- 50 youth participated in 'Debunking Corruption' training.
- 10 youth-led Youth Activism Clubs established in 10 urban and rural municipalities, with 100+ members utilizing activism as a tool to raise awareness, mobilize the youth and inspire local community change.
